MICHALIS ECONOMOU

DIRETTUR TAL-ORKESTRA

Michalis Economou huwa wieħed mill-aktar konduttur u kompożituri attivi tal-ġenerazzjoni tiegħu, u huwa personaġġ sinifikanti fix-xena mużikali Griega. Huwa d-direttur mużikali tal-Orkestra Sinfonika tar-Radju Griega, il-konduttur ewlieni tal-Orkestra Sinfonika ta' Ateni, l-eks direttur mużikali tal-Orkestra Filarmonika tal-Qatar, u l-president tad-dipartiment tal-mużika fl-Università Teknika ta' Ateni.

Barra minn hekk, bħala konduttur mistieden regolari tal-orkestri Griegi kollha, ħadem ukoll ma' aktar minn 30 orkestra sinfonika fl-Ewropa, l-Istati Uniti u l-Asja. Twieled il-Greċja, studja l-mużikologija fl-Università ta' Ateni kif ukoll il-vjolin, it-teorija u l-kompożizzjoni fil-Konservatorju Nazzjonali ta' Ateni. Ingħata ħames boroż ta' studju meta mar jgħix Boston fl-1997, fejn kiseb grad ta' Master's fit-tmexxija orkestrali u

Dottorat fil-kompożizzjoni. Michalis Economou huwa l-professur attwali tat-tmexxija orkestrali fil-Konservatorju storiku ta' Ateni u mill-2003 'l hawn ħarreg lil mill-inqas sebgħin konduttur żagħżuġ. Huwa wkoll il-fundatur u d-direttur tal-masterclass nazzjonali annwali tat-tmexxija orkestrali mal-Orkestra Sinfonika ta' Ateni, li tattira lil mill-inqas mitt konduttur żagħżuġ kull staġun. Barra minn hekk, kien il-fundatur u t-tutor ta' ħamsa mill-iktar masterclasses internazzjonali importanti fit-tmexxija orkestrali, fl-Ungerija, Malta, il-Greċja, ir-Rumanija u Ċipru. Sa mill-2012, Michalis Economou huwa rappreżentat internazzjonalment minn IMG Artists.

Gillian hija artista regolari fil-Festival Internazzjonali tal-Barokk tal-Belt Valletta u tat rappreżentazzjonijiet ukoll fil-Festival tal-Mużika Bikrija ta' Utrecht fl-Olanda u fil-Festival Musica Sacra f'Napli fl-Italja.

Il-kredenzjali televiżivi tagħha jinkludu l-parti b'hala s-Swan ewlenija fis-serje ta' Netflix Peaky Blinders, kif ukoll b'hala koreografa għall-film ta' Hallmark, The Dancing Detective: A deadly Tango. Hija dehret ukoll b'hala l-kap tal-ġurija

fl-ispettaklu tat-talenti televiżiv Brillanti għas-sensiela taż-żfin tal-2023 u b'hala artista solista għall-mużiċist li rebaħ diversi unuri Sting, fil-Las Vegas Residency tiegħu.

MICHALIS ECONOMOU

CONDUCTOR

Michalis Economou is one of the most active conductors and composers of his generation, a significant figure of the Greek musical scene. He is music director of the Greek Radio Symphony Orchestra, chief conductor of the Athens Symphony Orchestra, former music director of the Qatar Philharmonic Orchestra, and chairman of the music department at the Athens Technical University. A regular guest conductor of all Greek orchestras, he has also worked with more than 30 symphony orchestras in Europe, the United States and Asia.

Born in Greece, he studied musicology at Athens University as well as violin, theory, and composition at the National Conservatory of Athens. He received five scholarships when he moved to Boston in 1997, earning a Master's degree in orchestral conducting and a Doctorate in

composition. Michalis Economou is the current orchestral conducting professor at the historical Athens Conservatoire and has trained at least seventy young conductors since 2003.

He is also the founder and director of the annual national conducting masterclass with the Athens Symphony Orchestra that attracts at least one hundred young conductors per season. Additionally, he has been the founder and tutor of five of the most important international conducting masterclasses today, in Hungary, Malta, Greece, Romania, and Cyprus. Since 2012 Michalis Economou is represented internationally by IMG Artists.



GILLIAN ZAMMIT

SOPRANO

Gillian Zammit began her vocal training with Antoinette Miggiani and Paul Asciani and went on to study in Italy with Carlo Bergonzi and Victoria de los Angeles.

Operatic productions include *Semele* and *The Turn of The Screw*, Gianni Schicchi, and *Hansel and Gretel*. She is a regular performer at Teatru Manoel, productions there include *Rigoletto* and *Die Zauberflöte* both conducted by Michael Laus and the role of Euridice in Gluck's opera *Orfeo* conducted by Philip Walsh. She has worked with many established artists including Joseph Calleja, Eugene Kohn, Emma Kirkby, and Plácido Domingo.

Gillian is highly regarded as a recital singer with a varied repertoire of Lieder, Spanish, and French song having performed Richard Strauss' *Four Last Songs* and Berlioz's *Les Nuits d'Été* amongst others. She is also a respected exponent of Baroque music and performs regularly with the Valletta International Baroque Ensemble (VIBE) with whom she has performed in Paris, Madrid, Berlin, and Brussels. Gillian is a regular artist in the Valletta International Baroque Festival and has also performed at the Utrecht Early Music Festival in Holland and the Naples Musica Sacra Festival in Italy.

She released her debut CD entitled *The Love Songs of Paolo Tosti* with pianist Lucia Micallef for UK record label Claudio Records. A more recent recording is *Kantilena* a CD of art songs with harpist Britt Arend and cellist Frank Camilleri under the auspices of the Malta Philharmonic Orchestra and Parma Recordings. Gillian has performed in Germany, America, UK, France, Armenia, Spain, and Romania.



MARVIC MONREAL

MEZZO-SOPRANO

Maltese mezzo-soprano Marvic Monreal owns a beautiful and powerful voice with a rare combination of darkness and luminosity. She started her training with Gillian Zammit in Malta, and then studied at the Royal Academy in London. Marvic is a former member of the Opera Studio of Frankfurt where her roles included Martha (Iolanta), Lucia (La gazza ladra), The Deaconess (Król Roger), La Maestra delle Novizie (Suor Angelica), and Olga (Eugene Onegin).

During her time at the Royal Academy of Music, she performed Carmen (La tragédie de Carmen), Mrs Peachum (Die Dreigroschenoper), Venus (Orphée aux enfers), and Bradamante (Alcina). Additional roles include Dido (Dido and Aeneas), Mercedes (Carmen) and Daniel (Belshazar) in Malta; Tisbe (La Cenerentola) for the New Generation
